WINNING SEASON eased back from inside the leaders on the first turn, advanced three wide into the second turn, challenged soon after, raced BEAUGESTE into defeat entering the stretch and drew off under brisk urging. BAXTER HALL outrun for a half, advanced three wide on the second turn but lodged only a mild bid for the place. BEAUGESTE vied for the early lead three wide, moved in a bit on the backstretch, held on well to the stretch and tired. AMANUENSIS forced the early pace four wide, held on well to the stretch and faded. SO WELCOME close up in the two path, faded in the final quarter. FLEXIBLE PRINCESS could not menace. PLAID was no factor.
