**Footnotes**

MISS A. BOMB behind the leaders four wide, challenged with a quarter mile to go, gained a short lead in midstretch and proved narrowly best. GEM SLEUTH within striking distance three wide, rallied willingly late to be steadily getting to the winner. CHIPPEWA COURT never far back off the inside, closed well in traffic. SPARTAN QUEEN vied for the lead along the inside and held on gamely. CABBAGE KEY outrun early, saved ground on the turn and made a late bid. BETTERN BISCUITS outsprinted early, was in close quarters near the three furlong marker then was no threat. TIME TO INDULGE rushed along the inside after a bit of a sluggish beginning, tired late. ADORABELL lost her footing at the start, was outrun early and could not menace. DANCIN BOOTS four wide on the turn, could not menace. JAMIE'S MAMBO in the four path on the turn when within striking distance, faded. HIDDEN GROVE (GB) forced the pace off the inside and gave way. STRIPED FLAG outrun early, raced five wide late on the turn and could not menace.
