CREDIT CRUNCH within striking distance off the rail, challenged in upper stretch when the leader drifted out to the five path then drew off late. HELEN BELEN set the pace in the three path, drifted wide leaving the turn allowing the winner to challenge, could not cope with that one in the stretch but held on for the place. MISS DORA forwardly placed from the start, moved up four wide on the turn to challenge, was carried wide leaving the turn and tired. FORTUNE PLAY unprepared at the start, stumbled breaking, made a quick recovery and pressed the pace inside but tired in the drive. WANTA GO within striking distance five wide, gave way. BIOGIO'S GIFT was outrun three wide.
