VAGUE REPORT chased leader to the final turn, floated off the rail into the stretch and quickly drew off in the final furlong. BURKE'S SISTER had good position to the final turn, roused while bearing out a bit into the stretch run and rallied to get up for place late. KEEPSAKE COPY set a commanding pace past the quarter pole but was used up and tired through the drive. SCOTLAND PLACE trailed for three quarters and made a belated run in the stretch. DAKOTA DIM raced evenly and lacked a late response after altering course in the upper stretch area. SLICK MISS was never a threat. ELECTRIC RANGE was through after a half.
