MORE THAN THOUGHT bobbled at the start and stalked the pace while five wide, rallied into the stretch and dueled, was all out to hold sway late. GO LYDIA GO was in a good stalking position on the outside, rallied on the far turn and took the lead, gave way grudgingly. LADY WYNNNE was well placed in mid pack, rallied on the second turn and into the stretch, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. CHAMP LAILA was void of early speed while seven wide and lost ground, had a late rally and was gaining but too late. COMMADORE KATE stalked the pace while five wide, rallied on the second turn, hung and ran evenly late. WINDS DUE EAST showed good early speed chasing the pace, faltered and faded. MUSICAL BREW failed to menace. SHINE OLA lunged at the start and then bobbed, was never a threat. BIG SIS AND TWINS was no threat. CHILE TEQUILA set the pace with good early speed, gave way and dropped back. O MOON was well placed while four wide, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and dropped back, was vanned off after the race.
