Footnotes

MISS ROMEO never far back off the inside, challenged before a half, gained command on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. BATES HONOR outspurred early, advanced four wide on the second turn, reached closest to the winner in midstretch but lacked a late bid. KAT CAN DANCE forced the early pace off the inside and tired in the stretch. BANNERSTONE vied for the lead near the rail and faded in the stretch. EXCLUSIVE SPA striking distance along the inside, gave way. SILENT COUNTER reserved early three wide, was no threat. CHICK'S HOPE outrun early four wide, stayed in that path and was no factor. TRICKY PRINCESS was no factor. RICKS LITTLE MUSIC angled in early, was outrun. PLAYFUL SQUAW forced the early pace three wide, moved out to be five wide for the second turn and stopped.
