OUR MIMI outsprinted early, advanced between rivals midway through the turn, came four wide into the stretch and rallied willingly to be clear late. RAISING KEENE four wide into the turn when setting the pace, angled in a bit with three furlongs, managed a clear advantage into the final furlong but was no match for the winner late. R B WOMEN reserved off the inside, improved her position while no threat. ISLAND SAGA four wide on the turn, was no threat. SWEET ATTRACTION behind the leaders along the inside, tired. GHAZADA was outrun. MISTRESS IN RED forced the pace from the start, raced five wide into the turn, stayed on well to the stretch and stopped. MISS LAABITY fractious in the gate, was no factor.
