Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, September 22, 2005 by payment of \$3,750 each (includes all fees). \$60,000 Guaranteed plus \$15,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds; 119 lbs.; Older; 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstake since April 18, allowed, 2 lbs.; \$30,000 since May 1, 4 lbs.; \$22,500 twice in 2004-2005, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. LEVEL PLAYINGFIELD outrun for a half three wide, settled suddenly in upper stretch and closed fast to be up in time. KORBYN GOLD set the pace along the inside and held on gamely but was outfinished. WITH DISTINCTION closest to the pace off the inside, finished willingly. ELUSIVE JAZZ within striking distance near the rail, angled out entering the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. STERLING GOLD outrun early, raced four wide into the turn, angled in approaching the stretch and rallied well. PRIVATE HORDE prompted the pace three wide and gave way. ESPRIT DU ROI (CHI) was no threat three wide. DEER LAKE stumbled at the start, made a quick recovery, raced four wide on the turn and faded in the drive.
