FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$1,000 to enter and \$1,000 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry Thursday, September 22, 2011 by payment of \$10,000 each (includes all fees). \$150,000 Association money Guaranteed. Plus \$50,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. After payment of 1% Association money to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining Association purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three-Year-Olds 120 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I Stake at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade II Stake at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade III Stake at a mile or over in 2011 allowed 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2011. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Thursday, September 15, 2011 with 32 Nominations.

FUTURE PROSPECT dueled for the lead and set the slow pace, responded when asked and drew clear in upper stretch, was all out to hold sway late. GENERAL QUARTERS was in a good stalking position while four wide, rallied on the second turn and loomed boldly, could not get by the winner late but gave way grudgingly. DEMARCATION was unhurried early while four and five wide, improved position in the stretch but was no threat. WORKIN FOR HOPS was well placed on the inside, ran evenly with no rally. BARYSHNIKOV was unhurried early while seven wide and lost ground, had nor ally. STRIKE IMPACT dueled for the lead and set the pace on the inside, faltered and faded. HAVELOCK pressed the pace with good early speed while five wide, gave way and dropped back. SHEDIK (FR) bobbled at the start and then failed to menace.
