LOU'S ANGEL duelled for the lead and pressed the pace, rallied on the turn and took the lead in upper stretch, drew clear while well off the rail under firm handling. DR. DIAMONDS PRIZE duelled for the lead and set the pace from the inside, weakened in the stretch but gamely held the place. RATTLIN GYSPY was in a good stalking position while six wide, rallied into the stretch and loomed a threat, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. HELEN BELEN showed good early speed while saving ground, gave way and dropped back. HUNGRY TIGRESS was no factor. MINEWANDER flashed brief speed before stopping. SERIOUSLY was unhurried early, rallied on the turn, hung and faded.
