Footnotes

BRADFORD B, reserved early when forwardly placed but well back of the leaders, commenced his rally four wide on the turn and closed fast in the final furlong to be up in time. DE HERO advanced inside on the turn, was angled out in upper stretch and stretch and finished well between rivals to miss. BOONE'S TOWN, forwardly placed from the start, was four wide into the turn, moved in a bit with three furlongs to go, took over in upper stretch and held on gamely while not able to last. LOAN SHARK, outrun early, raced six wide into the turn, moved in bit with three furlongs to run but could only improve his position. CLOSETOTHEPOWER, reserved early along the inside, was no factor. JAKAL sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside, moved to the rail in the stretch and tired. TROUBADOUR, unhurried early, was four wide into the turn and could not menace. BOLD BRUSH bobbled after the start, was outrun and was never a factor. SOULARD SWIRL, closest to the pace in the three path, faded in the drive. SILVER SPREE, outrun early, raced five wide into the turn and never contended. BOSTON NORTHEEND rushed early to within striking distance, stopped.
