Footnotes

REGALLY APPEALING, six wide early when forwardly placed while reserved, challenged four wide on the second turn when ready and slowly drew clear in the drive under steady urging. HUMBLE CLERK, angled in when outrun early, commenced her rally with three furlongs to go, angled out four wide entering the stretch and closed fast on the outside to be going best at the finish. ASHER vied for the lead off the inside, moved to the rail with less than three furlongs to go and held on gamely in the drive. CRAWLEYVILLE squeezed back entering the first turn, recovered to be a forward factor off the inside, continued well to midstretch but lacked the needed late bid. CHEROKEE IN SOLANO steadied along the inside entering the first turn, was reserved early, made a five wide run on the second turn to a challenging position but weakened in the drive. MYCATCANDANCE steadied when squeezed back entering the first turn, recovered to be a forward factor, made a mild gain four wide on the second turn but tired in the final furlong. PICNICIN', squeezed back entering the first turn, recovered to race within striking distance, raced three wide on the second turn and tired. OATSEE, unhurried early four wide, was no threat. LADY GIN stumbled at the start, recovered quickly, raced five wide into the first turn when pressing the pace, continued well to the quarter pole and stopped. FAITHFUL HEART, unhurried early five wide, raced six wide into the stretch and could not menace. APOLLO CAT took up entering the first turn, was outrun and was never a factor.
