SUCCESSFUL APPEAL, forwardly placed well out in the strip, advanced five wide on the turn, challenged approaching the stretch and drew off under steady handling. FIVE STAR DAY set the pace, while well out in the strip, moved in to the three path on the turn, responded willingly when challenged before a half, was no match for the winner while best of the others. AMERICAN SPIRIT, unhurried early, made a mild gain five wide on the turn but tired in the stretch. HIDDEN CITY lost his footing a bit after the start, recovered to race within striking distance while kept off the rail but tired in the drive. ISITEVER, unhurried early, raced in the three path on the turn and was no factor. FREESPOOL bobbled a the start, recovered quickly and raced closest to the pace while well out in the strip, came in to be four wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and tired.
