Footnotes

FIRST TIME opened clear to set the pace, dug in gamely to meet the challenge of SPECTER nearing the furlong marker and was fully extended to end on even terms for the win. SPECTER stalked the pace three wide, launched a bold bid entering the stretch, drew even and continued on willingly to finish in a dead heat with FIRST TIME. MR ED M settled in hand, came four wide to make a steady advance and was along for the show. CHOCOLATE CREAM attended the pace along the inside, angled out to make a mild bid three wide leaving the second turn but lacked the needed late response. NAFASS was

unhurried into stride, came four wide to make a belated gain from between horses but failed to seriously threaten. DEPUTY ALYDAR chased the pace three wide to the second turn, then along the inside into the stretch, but faltered after six furlongs and faded. RUSSIAN AFFAIR settled between horses in the second flight and failed to respond. SEATTLE FIZZ made a middle move five wide but failed to sustain the drive. JACK SPARROW broke awkwardly and showed little. ADDISON N CLARK raced wide throughout and was outrun.
