WORKINONTHRAILROAD bobbled at the start, dueled for the lead and set the pace, drew off in upper stretch, was all out to just last late. SAVIANO stalked the pace with good early speed, rallied into the stretch but found his best stride late and was gaining. WATERSHED EVENT showed good early speed while six wide, rallied on the far turn and lost ground, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. PSYCHIC INCOME was void of early speed, improved position but was no factor. PARADE BOLDLY was unhurried early, passed tiring rivals. SIX SHOTS (GB) flashed brief speed before stopping. FREEBEERTOMORROW failed to menace. CHANGING STORM showed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. GOOGLEZ DE CERVEZA stumbled at the start and then was rushed up and dueled, was used up and stopped.
