RERAISE ridden early to set the pace, moved clear on the turn then drew off under mild urging. COPELAN TOO unhurried early, altered course at the 3/16 pole when rallying then finished willingly to be up for the place. MR BERT prompted the pace off the inside but tired in the drive. HITECH prominent from start, raced four wide on the turn and gave way in the drive. BAQUERO never far back between rivals, was angled in on the turn but faded in the drive. BAD STORM COMIN' outrun inside, never menaced. EX MARKS THE COP pressed the pace three wide while between rivals and stopped.
