FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 23, 2009 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds; 118 lbs.; Older; 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake at a mile or over since March 15, allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over in 2009, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2009, 6 lbs. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2009. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, September 16, 2009 with 27 Nominations.

INDESCRIBABLE reserved off the inside, angled out on the backstretch, moved up four wide on the second turn, caught the leaders in midstretch and drew off late. UNFORGOTTEN outrun for a half, raced three wide once on the second turn, came to the outside for the drive and closed well to be up for the place. WHIRLIE BERTIE sprinted clear into the first turn, was rated while setting the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged by BEAR NOW on the second turn, battled that one into midstretch, attempted to run with the winner when that one ranged up on the outside but faltered late. BEAR NOW closest to the pace three wide, challenged the leader when ready on the second turn, pressured that one to the final furlong and tired late. IRISH RIDGE stumbled at the start, recovered to race behind the leaders in the two path, angled out a bit when moving closer on the second turn, maintained good position to the final furlong and lacked a late bid. FRENCH KISS outrun to the stretch, was no threat. MS. MARGARET H. reserved off the inside, was no factor. MADLY within striking distance early near the rail, stopped.
