Footnotes

SISTER BAY within striking distance off the inside, challenged in upper stretch and proved narrowly best. CELESTIAL WOODS forwardly placed, was carried nine wide midway through the turn when moving to challenge, was bumped entering the stretch then rallied willingly but miss. SHOWMETHEGREATONE never far back along the inside, challenged entering the stretch, held on well to inside the final furlong and weakened. ALTIMETER vied for the lead in the three path, bore out on the turn, bumped CELESTIAL WOODS entering the stretch then tired. SWEET TEMPER outprinted early, saved ground on the turn, angled out a bit for the drive but lacked a late bid. TIMESWEPT reared at the start, was outrun to the stretch and made a good late gain. THUNDER AND BELLE pressed the pace from the start, was carried eight wide midway through the turn and tired. DONAMOUR prompted the pace between rivals and faded. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY, ALTIMERER WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SEVENTH FOR INTERFERENCE ON THE TURN.
