FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 24, 2008 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 since April 1 allowed 2 lbs.; non-winners of \$30,000 twice in 2008, 4 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2008. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, September 17, 2008 with 28 Nominations.

Footnotes

FATAL BULLET set the pressured pace between horses, shook clear entering the turn, was kept to task and drew away to score in track record time. SILVER SWORD stalked the pace four wide, launched his bid leaving the turn, was no match for the winner then was all out to just hold the place. NO ADVANTAGE settled into stride and angled in to save ground, ranged up from between horses through the turn, continued on willingly through the drive and was along for the show. HATTA FORT (GB) settled saving ground, shifted to the outside leaving the turn to make his bid, was carried out further entering the stretch, finished with some late run but was left with too much to do. SALUTE THE SARGE settled between horses under a snug hold, angled out leaving the turn to find room but lacked a response when called upon. NAUTICAL STORM prompted the pace along the inside to the stretch and gave way. BEYOND READY was hustled along four wide in mid pack but was never a factor. GENTLEMAN JAMES contended between horses three wide early, dropped off of the pace through the turn and showed little thereafter. THAT'S GRAND chased the pace between horses for a half and stopped.
