FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS. By subscription of \$100, \$500 to enter and \$500 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, September 24, 2008 by payment of \$5,000 each (includes all fees). \$100,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Stake allowed 2 lbs.; of a Sweepstakes, 4 lbs.; of two races other than claiming, 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. WEST SIDE BERNIE settled between horses three wide to attend the pace, reeled in the leaders nearing the three-eighths pole, shook clear entering the stretch, kept to task increased his advantage. RETAP pressed the pace two wide, drew even from between horses nearing the quarter pole, was unable to match strides with the winner through the drive but continued on willingly to prove second best. GRESHAM attended the pace along the inside, shifted out to the three path to make his bid entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. JUST LIKE BISCUIT was forwardly placed four wide, dropped back a bit through the second turn, came again with a mild rally but failed to threaten. TAR BEACH was allowed to settle three wide, came four wide to make a mild gain but was never a factor. PROUD JEFE set the pressured pace along the inside, was collared leaving the second turn and gave way readily through the stretch. SIR BUBBA saved ground to no avail.
