JOE SIX PACK squeezed back at the start, was outrun early, advanced seven wide into the turn, angled in a bit approaching the stretch then closed well to be clear late. GENERAL PURPOSE within striking distance four wide, challenged on the turn and held on for the place. EL POCO DIABLO close up three wide, challenged on the turn, took over with a furlong to go but faltered late. ZEKE within striking distance, raced in the three path on the turn and lacked a late bid. TWOSTEP PARTNER outsprinted early off the inside, improved his position on the turn then went evenly late. HOWDY BOY RIB outrun early, raced five wide into the turn and could not threaten. STEVE'S REVENGE within striking distance, raced six wide into the turn and tired. BROTHER RON five wide with three furlongs to go, was outrun. CAB was no factor. YOU IS WHAT YOU IS close up while off the inside, stopped. OUR TWO set the pace, held on well to the final quarter and stopped. GOLD APPEAL five wide with three furlongs to go when within striking distance, stopped.
