### Footnotes

DON'TGETMADGETEVEN stalked the pace in hand, took over midway through the turn, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely. ARCHIE TRUCKER was bumped at the start, contended between horses, was it tight and steadied before going a quarter, shifted to the outside, circled eight wide and kept on well to earn the place. SOULADAR opened clear to set the early place, was collared on the turn, weakened entering the stretch but stayed on to hold the show. YOU IS WHAT YOU IS was unhurried into stride, got through toward the inside entering the stretch and improved position. ESPRESSO JOE attended the pace off of the inside, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. BLUE CHERRIES SPIN settled saving ground, angled out leaving the turn but lacked a response when asked. MANHASSET INDIAN was never a factor. FORPETEYSSAKE stumbled at the start, moved up along the inside, but came up empty entering the stretch and dropped out. DISQUALIFIED SOULADAR FROM THIRDF TO LAST PURSE MONEY PER STEWARDS RULING #12-0126 AND REDISTRIBUTED PURSE MONEY ACCORDINGLY.
