Footnotes

ONE HOT GATOR stalked the pace, forged command leaving the second turn, kicked clear entering the stretch, dug in to meet the challenge of POMMETTE in the final sixteenth and was all out to just last. POMMETTE was allowed to settle, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, loomed large four wide entering the stretch, kept on well but wasn't quite good enough. VOODOO'S VISION pulled clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the second turn, gave way but had enough left to hold the show. TELLALITTLESECRET was unhurried into stride, came five wide but found his best stride too late. CHINA MELISSA was forwardly placed three wide to the stretch and tired. KENYAFLY broke slow, moved up along the inside, but came up empty on the second turn and dropped out. KENTUCKY KITTY was outrun.
