SEPTEMBER CEREMONY close up early four wide, challenged on the second turn and edged off late under pressure. VIA DI ROMA close up three wide, challenged before a half, gained a short lead, responded when engaged by the winner on the second turn and held on gamely to be second best. RIP SNORTER close up early off the rail, saved ground on the second turn and lacked a late bid. BOYSI'MHERE within striking distance, lost position on the second turn then made a late bid. MODEL'S MEMO outsprinted early, made a good four wide middle move but failed to respond late. MISSZOEY BELLE set the early pace inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. BURL'S JUNIANA failed to menace. CUZSHEZAWESOME outrun early, was no factor. FINEST VISION trailed.
