SMOKIN STAR reserved early, made a run four wide after a half, challenged on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. BUSTANAI outrun early, made a good four wide move on the second turn but lodged only a mild bid to be second best. LUCKIE CHUCKIE unhurried off the inside, was no real threat. ST. ARMANDS reserved in the four path, made a good four wide middle move but tired in the drive. CUSTERS LAST STAND was no factor vanned off after pulling up. SOUPED UP FAST behind the leaders inside, moved out to the three path on the second turn and faded. MAGICAL STORM alternated for the early lead four wide, took over before a half, angled in to race off the rail on the second turn and stopped. SEND A SPIRIT vied for the lead in the three path, moved to the inside on the second turn and stopped.
