

MARGE S sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and lasted while fully extended. IS THIS GOOD closest to the pace three wide, rallied willingly but just missed. PREDATORY LENDER reserved three wide, advanced four wide on the second turn to a forward position but lacked a late bid. CASUARINA never far back off the inside early, went evenly in the drive. SPECIAL JIG outrun early, angled out five wide with three furlongs go to and made a mild late gain. DYNABIN far back for six furlongs, was no threat. PAUSE FOR APPLAUSE stumbled at the start and could not menace. ENJOYTHE AFTERNOON forwardly placed three wide, gave way. SUN BAY was no factor. BABYGOTDABLUES close up early along the inside, stopped.
