SARATOGA SEVEN with the pace six wide, drew clear under pressure. CAPE HATTERAS vied for the lead along the inside, dropped back a bit late on the turn then came again for the place. MACKINAW forced the pace five wide and tired. LARAMIE WOODS outrun early, raced in the four path late on the turn and was no real threat. TIP TOP H. A. T. behind the leaders along the inside on the turn, dropped back and angled out approaching the stretch, was carried six wide leaving the turn and had no late bid. NAJRIN steadied early when in tight, was carried seven wide entering the stretch when rallying then could not menace. MASTER PLAN outrun early, was carried eight wide approaching the stretch when rallying then could not sustain the bid. MR MACCOOL forced the pace three wide, drifted five wide entering the stretch and faded. GRAND MOUNTAIN alternated for the lead four wide and faded. THE WRECKER pressed the pace off the inside and stopped. IDONOTLIKEIT was outrun. BRIAR CAT was outrun.
