Footnotes

MOUNT LEMON within striking distance three wide, angled out four wide leaving the second turn and closed well on the outside to be up in time. UNLOOSENED reserved early along the inside, was angled out on the backstretch, made a three wide move on the second turn, gained a short lead inside the final furlong but was outfinished. PHIL THE GRIP pressed the pace outside KIMBERLITE PIPE, challenged that one with three furlongs to go, gained a short lead in upper stretch but weakened late. KIMBERLITE PIPE set the pace along the inside, moved off the rail leaving the second turn but tired in the final furlong. GLACIAL forwardly placed between rivals, raced three wide on the second turn and tired. COAST OF MANE close up along the inside while restrained, gave way in the drive. IRISH SILENCE outrun early, was no threat and was being eased up late.
