TOO SASSY FOR U pressed the pace between rivals, took over when ready in upper stretch and drew off late under steady urging. CIMPLY SAVIO outrun early along the inside, made a run on the rail on the second turn, angled out for the drive and finished willingly to be up for the place. WICKETTE behind the leaders from the start, angled outside on the backstretch and tired in the drive. TIME FOR GRACE vied for the lead along the inside and tired in the final furlong. WESTERN TYPE pressed the pace three wide, was taken in hand and eased back from between the leaders, angled to the inside after a half, saved ground while reserved on the second turn then could not threaten. RECKLESS ABANDON four wide on the first turn when forwardly placed, challenged before a half but faded after six furlongs. KATE DANAHER outrun early, was pulled up after three furlongs.
