STAKES Kentucky Cup Classic S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200, \$1,750 to enter and \$1,750 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry Wednesday, September 27, 2006 by payment of \$20,000 each (includes all fees).

\$200,000 Guaranteed plus \$150,000 KTDf for KTDf eligibles only. Monies to be divided: 62% to the owner of the winner; 20% to second; 10% to third; 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Any KTDf money not awarded will revert back to the fund. Weight:

Three-Year-Olds 120 lbs.; Older 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I Stake at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade II Stake at a mile or over in 2006, 4 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade III Stake at a mile or over in 2006 allowed 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) starters.

Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2006. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Closed Wednesday, September 20, 2006 with 32 Nominations.

**Footnotes**

BALL FOUR set the pace off the inside while under patient handling, drifted out a bit after PREMIUM TAP clipped his heels near the three furlong marker, repulsed a bid by GREELEY'S GALAXY after six furlongs, drew clear then lasted late. PERFECT DRIFT reserved off the inside, moved closer in that path on the second turn, was blocked with a furlong to go, angled in a bit for room split rivals near the sixteenth marker then closed well late. GOOD REWARD unhurried for a half near the inside, steadied behind PREMIUM TAP near the three furlong marker then that one clipped heels, angled out for the drive and closed well on the outside. ALUMNI HALL forwardly placed, was carried out when moving closer four wide on the second turn then lacked the needed closing bid. PREMIUM TAP close up along the inside while in hand, accelerated quickly once in the second turn, clipped the winners heels and stumbled near the three furlong marker when attempting to move through along the inside, dropped back a bit, recovered, made a good run to a challenging position nearing the furlong marker but hung late. GREELEY'S GALAXY forced the pace off the inside, was carried out a bit when three wide with three furlongs to go and held on gamely. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE RIDER OF PREMIUM TAP AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
