**Footnotes**

RIDGE CITY settled in hand, reeled in the leaders four wide leaving the second turn, kicked clear and held the fast closing RIDE IN THE PARK at bay. RIDE IN THE PARK was allowed to settle, advanced between horses through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch, finished with a rush but was unable to reach the winner. PURE LUCKY ANGEL opened clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch, gave way but had enough left to hold the show. KAFWAIN BLUE was allowed to settle, closed the gap two wide through the second turn, shifted to the outside for the final furlong and improved position. MCCANDY MAN attended the pace along the inside, moved out a bit and bid between rivals entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. NAVAJO PARK settled saving ground, made a belated gain but failed to threaten. FERRIS passed only the tiring ones. GO KENNY GO chased the pace three wide, but came up empty from between horses entering the stretch and retreated. B. MONSOUR was hustled along four wide while never far back, but tired before going six furlongs and dropped out. ROUGH STOCK was forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn and faded. TACKING DUEL was through early and distanced through the stretch.
