THUNDER AND BELLE attended the pace off of the inside under a snug hold, wheeled out five wide leaving the turn, wore down the leader inside the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. MARGARET PRIDE set the pressured pace along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to preserve the place. HERE COMES ALEXIS stalked the pace four wide, launched her bid leaving the turn but lacked the needed late kick. SEDUCING MR. G was allowed to settle, angled out to make a late rally but was making up ground too late. MISS BOCEPHUS was close up off of the inside, split horses and made a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. ALEDO EXPECTATION was allowed to settle, came five wide but lacked a response when called upon. PRINCESS LANGFUHR passed the tiring ones. CHA CHING failed to respond. JACOB'S QUEEN showed little. STARTLING was outrun. IN CASE OF SNOW pressed the pace three wide to the stretch and stopped.
