**Footnotes**

BIG NOTION closest to the pace three wide, challenged on the turn and drew clear under steady urging. CALL ME SIR within striking distance, saved ground on the turn, moved closest to the winner after a half but lacked a closing bid. AZIRULE within striking distance, raced six wide midway through the turn and had nothing left late. JUJU outrun early, raced six wide out of the turn and lacked a late bid. ISLE HOPE unhurried early while off the inside, made a mild run to midstretch but had no late bid. IRON FORTITUDE outrun early, angled out six wide approaching the stretch and could not menace. GIVEN CREDIT trailed for a half, came seven wide into the stretch and was no factor. STAR FOR JACK prominent from the start, moved out five wide midway through the turn and faded. TWO STEP HERO close up while off the inside, faded. WAKES WEEK was no threat. OCALA PROSPECT set the pace, held on well to the stretch and stopped.
