Footnotes

HONGKONG SUPERSTAR prompted the pace three wide, forged a narrow lead after a half, shook clear entering the stretch then was all out to just last. SUDDENLY PERFECT settled saving ground, angled out to launch his bid, split horses entering the stretch, finished full of run but just missed. JUICY POINT was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling six wide and was along for the show. I'VE HEARD IT ALL made a middle move four wide, drew even leaving the second turn, but weakened during the drive and gave way. PROTECTOROFALLEVIL stalked the pace off of the inside, angled to the inside entering the stretch, got through but lacked the needed late kick. BEHREN'S LEGACY was allowed to settle, angled out to make a mild gain but failed to seriously threaten. TARAGE settled in the second flight and failed to respond. BEARSREADY made a belated gain five wide. DIPLOMATIC CODE made

an early move four wide, but came up empty leaving the second turn and faded. SHADES OF HOPE raced wide throughout and was never a factor. STEVE'S REVENGE vied for the lead between horses, but came up empty before going six furlongs and retreated. KANZEL disputed the pace along the inside for a half and stopped.
