GALA REGATTA sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and stayed clear under steady urging. NUGENT'S CROSSROAD within striking distance, commenced her rally four wide on the turn and finished willingly late. WINDWARD CAT outsprinted early, saved ground on the turn, angled out a bit in the stretch and closed well inside rivals. BELLE'S BLAZE never far back four wide, lacked the needed closing bid. MISS POMPEI outrun early, raced in the four path out of the turn and made a late gain. SUCH AN ALLEY CAT reserved off the inside, lodged a mild bid. PRINCESS FALINA forwardly placed three wide, tired. APRIL FIRST close up along the inside, gave way. KATE CAMPBELL was outrun. PEAR 'N GINGER prompted the pace three wide and faded. DARCI'S TAP SHOES stopped.
