QUICK TEMPER closest to the pace three wide, challenged in upper stretch, took over in midstretch then held sway late. MAE RULES outrun early, made a good three wide run on the second turn, reached a forward position in deep stretch but hung late. SECRET CRUSH set the pace off the inside but weakened late. GO GRACE GO four wide on the first turn when forwardly placed, weakened in the stretch. BOOM BABY lost footing start, reserved early, moved to contention along the inside after a half, raced in traffic leaving the turn and had no late bid. POPOZINHA within striking distance along the inside, tired in the stretch. ONE MORE MOONDANCE close up in the two path, gave way. SOMETHINGQUIET was no threat.
