ANNA DANA had good speed from the outset three wide, settled and took over through the final furlong but was outfinished late. COUNTRY DIVA showed speed from inside to stretch, raced out from the rail through the and faded in the late stages. UNION CREEK bore in at the start, raced in good position but lacked a response when needed. NICE DANCE steadied a bit after the start then was no real threat from outside. SIMPLY ENCHANTING raced evenly and the lacked late response needed. KINDA STORMY no real threat. WITCH BAY was no factor. KITTY FOILLE forced in at the start then was no threat. RAH RAH GIRL was through after half. BOND BEAUTY forced in at the start, rushed up and was through early. PERPETUAL CHANGE never a threat.
