SAVANNAH'S PRIZE outrun early, advanced while off the inside on the second turn, angled out a bit for the drive and rallied willingly to be up in time. LADY BERKLEY vied for the lead off the inside, took over on the second turn but was outfinished. JOVE'S AUBEE within striking distance three wide, made a mild gain four wide past the three furlong marker but lacked a late bid. PADDOCK PASS close up along the inside, dropped back a bit before a half then had little left late. INDIA INK outrun early, made a mild late bid. DIXIEHUNT within striking distance, raced three wide around the second turn and tired. BAG OF STARS forwardly placed off the inside, was three wide on the second turn and tired. WHAT A FILLY LES alternated for the lead along the inside and faded in the stretch. LA TORAH DE TARA was no factor. MY CHERIE PLAYMATE was no threat.
