### Footnotes

INDY CHEERS well placed early, lost position going into the turn, split horses into the stretch and edged clear in the final furlong then lasted in the drive. JOB SECURITY good position to the turn, went four wide for the drive and was gaining too late. GOLDEN LEIGH closest to the pace throughout, raced evenly and lacked the late response needed. QUITE A SIGHT showed speed from inside to deep stretch, held well through the final stages but faltered. MARCIELLA sprinted clear at once, hooked up to duel around turn but gave way. ANNA MY SWEETHEART hesitated at the start, stayed back for a half, and rallied wide to close the gap through the stretch run. IT CERTAINLY IS was never close. KORO SEA failed to respond. OUT OF THE MOOD had a steady fade. I'M FANTABULOUS never far back for a half but, faded in the stretch. ATLANTA BREEZE was no factor. GO CATS raced back early, pulled up for no apparent reason.
