LUCKY CHUCK chased the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn then made a bid in the stretch and edged past the leader in the final stages. BIG FLIRT set the pace early, while on the inside into the far turn then yielded late in the stretch drive. I COME FROM BEHIND stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faded late in the stretch. H. J. ARVIN tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and was empty in the stretch run. CORNWHISKEY angled into the five path in the far turn and improved position. SOL A PINO was never a threat. DONT POKE THE BEAR was done early. TENTH POWER stumbled at the start and was no factor.
