KRISTA was allowed to settle, circled six wide, took over with a furlong to run and edged clear. DYNARAMA stalked the pace four wide, drew even leaving the second turn, continued on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. LIZZIE BELLE vied for the lead three wide, weakened following a long drive but had enough left to preserve the show. VALENTINE CITY settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and improved position between rivals. AUDTON was allowed to settle, came seven wide and finished with a belated gain. WICHOLA was allowed to settle off of the inside, finished with a mild rally but was never a factor. FLEET LAUREN disputed the pace off of the inside to the stretch and faded. SPEEDY KITTEN was forwardly placed along the inside for six furlongs and retreated. CARLI'S SONG broke outwardly, was away slow and passed only the tiring ones. SPECIAL DIAMOND broke in the air and was outrun. TOOPRETTYFORWORDS was through early. EMERALD CURRENT stopped after a half.
