OUR NOBLE HEART stalked the pace four wide, ranged up to engage the leaders on the turn, shook clear entering the stretch and widened. COWCUTTA dueled toward the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but kept on well to prove best of the rest. DESERT DOC was unhurried into stride, advanced between horses through the turn, came seven wide and finished willingly to earn the show. BOLD OCCURANCE was forwardly placed along the inside, weakened during the drive and just missed for the show. GOT ZIP attended the pace off of the inside, came four wide but went evenly through the drive. KUMACANDU was allowed to settle between horses, finished with a mild rally while five wide but failed to threaten. SPY failed to respond. RAILROAD ROY was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, and passed only the tiring ones. HESMYTEMPTATION was never a factor. T MINUS THREE contended between horses for a half and tired. OL' HENRY stumbled at the start, recovered quickly and disputed the pace three wide through the

turn and dropped out. SEACLIPSE was jostled at the start to get away slow, went widest of all and showed little.
