Footnotes

SYRIAN MAIL, reserved for five furlongs, made a run four wide leaving the second turn, closed fast to the leader then held sway late. GO SILK, outrun inside while unhurried, waited on the second turn, was angled out to follow the winner and finished with good energy. MIRACLE, within striking distance, challenged three wide on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch but faltered late. PASS THE POKER, five wide early when outrun, made a run four wide on the second turn but could not menace. JEWELLED RANSOM, four wide on the first turn, moved to contention four wide on the second turn but could not sustain the bid. SAMATI was not a threat with a mild middle move. SHEVAR vied for the lead inside, gained command before a half but gave way in the drive. JINNYDOTS, within striking distance off the inside, moved closer on the second turn but tired in the drive. DYNELLA, ridden to vie for the lead off the inside, stayed well for six furlongs and faded. REGENCY ROAD, forwardly placed early inside, was angled out on the backstretch, made a mild gain four wide on the second turn but faded in the drive. IWASALL failed to menace. SLICE OF FAME, close up off the inside, stopped after a half.
