POWDERED WIG dueled entire way from the inside, repelled several bids and prevailed in a game effort. GO GRACE GO tracked the pace, gained through the stretch to just miss late. BEAUTY ON DUTY raced inside to stretch, angled out and was bumped by rival late and had no late bid. ANGELIC LIGHT no speed, rallied around the turn, angled out bumping rival in late stretch then angled in while evenly late. MAE RULES closest to pacesetters to deep stretch and faltered in the late going. SEND FOR AN ANGEL no speed, raced evenly and lacked a late response. VICTORY SPIRIT good speed from the rail, dueled winner for three quarters and tired. GOT PIZAZZ raced four wide throughout while never far back then gave little effort late. WAVE BABE was through after half.
