ISN'T SHE GREAT set the pace with a clear advantage, on the rail into the turn then drew clear in the stretch and lasted late. ANOTHER TALE was unhurried early, angled three wide into the turn then rallied in the stretch but was too late. C C'S PROSPECT raced up close early, angled five wide into the turn then made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough late. TAMBOS JAZZ DANCER lacked speed early, angled six wide into the turn and was gaining late. PHONE JOAN stalked the leader, angled off the rail into the turn and weakened in the drive. SILVER DOLLAR GIRL tracked the leader, angled three wide into the turn and was empty late. AMANDA'S WORLD angled three wide into the turn while no threat. FOG LIGHT angled five wide into the turn and faded. FREE 'N FOXY was never involved.
