Footnotes

SONG OF HUMOR vied from between horses, shook free around the turn, drew clear in the stretch and held sway late. CAVALERO had no speed to the turn, came four or five into the stretch but raced even late with no gain. HYDROPLANE never far back, came with a three wide bid into the stretch but flattened out in the drive. TIGERS LAST vied to the turn but weakened in the drive. ARTEMUS JOY was up close to the stretch, within striking distance at the eighth pole but bore out sharply in the final sixteenth. KASSTOOFAST was through early. GOLDDIGGING was never a factor. TAKES A THIEF bothered at the start, rushed from inside to vie early but gave way in the stretch run.
