MODEL'S MEMO chased leader to the stretch, wore that one down while being forced out through the final sixteenth. NOLA STAR sprinted cleat at once, made the pace to deep stretch, drifted out through the final stages and caught at the wire. KENTUCKY PEACHES raced six wide into first turn, drifted five wide at the quarter pole with a mild late run in the stretch. COMMADORE KATE unhurried early, rallied with mild bid in the stretch and flattened out in drive. ALBERTA'S BOOK was off slow and well back for a half, rallied up the rail and moved up late. THIMBLEBERRY was well placed for a half, came five or six wide into the stretch with no bid. MS TRANSFORMATIONS had good position to the quarter pole, three wide into stretch and faded in the drive. PLEASE CALL ME had no speed for three quarters, went widest into the stretch while no threat. SIMONE chased the pace for a half, off rail entering stretch and stopped thereafter.
