**Footnotes**

KITTY'S GOLD, wearing a nasal strip, drifted in early placing inner rivals in tight, set the pace off the inside and drew off in the drive under steady urging. MISS DUSTY in tight early, recovered and moved quickly to a forward position but was no match for the winner in the drive. TURK'S REGAL LADY within striking distance between rivals, launched her rally in upper stretch but lacked the needed late bid and finished on even terms with SKIP UP. SKIP UP forwardly placed off the inside, had nothing left in the drive and dead heated with TUCK'S REGAL LAD. PIENZA closest to the early pace along the inside, held well to the stretch and tired. DALLAS CHEERLEADER outrun early three wide, was no threat. JOJO'S MOODY GIRL within striking distance along the inside, gave way in the stretch. WINE ME DINE ME unhurried early three wide, was no factor. BEST GIRL UP steadied early when in tight then was outrun four wide. A foul claim by the rider of MISS DUSTY against the rider of the winner for interference after the start was not allowed.
