Footnotes

MICHAELS PARK stalked the pace three wide, launched his bid entering the stretch, poked his head in front with a furlong to run and drew clear. MOONBLAST attended pace along the inside, made a middle move to reel in the leader, loomed large entering the stretch but flattened during the drive. SIR SHAUN was awkward into stride, advanced between horses three wide, kept on well and was just up to earn the show. MCCOVEY COVE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. SUNDAY GROOM was unhurried into stride, angled in to save ground, made a late rally between horses and improved position. C. I. EDDIE sped clear to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed. PURE PRIZE GEORGE passed only the tiring ones. KID ROCKER failed to respond. LUCKY FOREST broke slow, rushed to contention between horses, but was used up after a half and retreated. TIGER WOZ was rank to place, pulled between horses for a half and dropped out. TRIPLE QUIZ was never a factor. GLORIOUS REVIEW was through early.
