**Footnotes**

ALL SNUFFED UP disputed the pace between horses, fought on through a long drive and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. CITY SEEKER set the pressured pace off of the inside, battled gamely but grudgingly gave in. THE CRUCIVERBALIST was allowed to settle, came five wide, split horses entering the stretch, finished well and was making up ground. ALYEYE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch and finished with a mild rally. DEAL WITH IT was close up five wide through the turn and faded. RED HARLEY broke slow, was unhurried into stride, angled out and improved position through the stretch. THUNDER ROW was unhurried into stride, swung to the outside but passed only the tiring ones. BUD THE GENERAL contended between horses to the stretch and faded. PEINADO failed to respond. WAR TALK was outrun. MUCHO CHICHARITO was through after a half. INDY AFTERNOON vied for the lead four wide through the turn and stopped.
